It was in the year 2010 when WIMLER extended help to poor deserving pupils of Mlang Pilot Elementary School. This was the time that Alvin was identified as one of the recipients of the scholarship assistance. Armed with strong determination to finish with his studies, Alvin worked hard and landed as one of the topnotchers in his class.
